WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH 2022

This month is an opportunity to bring right to the very front, the history of women in all areas of our national, regional and global past. At St Neot, we are proud of the rich and interesting history curriculum that we teach which includes many extraordinary women from the past.

In Treverbyn Class, we are currently learning about The Shang Dynasty and the tomb of Fu Hao, the wife of the Emperor, who is thought to have died around 1200 BC. Fu Hao was obviously a very rich and powerful person – unusually so for a woman in Shang times. She is said to have been a famous army leader who defended the country from invasion, as well as helping her husband to rule the country.

In Fowey Class, we have been learning about inspirational women such as Anne Frank, Mother Theresa, Malala Yousafzai and Hannah Cockcroft in our RE lessons.
