Going Wild

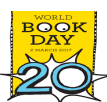
Let your imagination run wild, come to school dressed as an animal or explorer. £1 donation per child please.

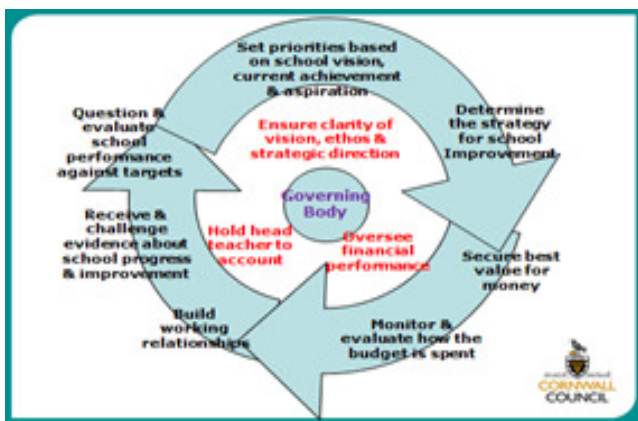
WORLD BOOK DAY
