## SPONSORED WALK/RUN/JOG/PRAM PUSH Sunday 21<sup>ST</sup> April 2024



St Neot School is holding a sponsored walk/run/jog around Sibilyback Lake on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> April 2024 to raise money for school funds.

No bikes or scooters please. Young children can be pushed in prams. Please wear suitable clothing and footwear.

We will undertake a risk assessment, check weather conditions and confirm with South West Lakes on the Friday prior to the event to ensure it is safe to take place.

Our PTA will be providing refreshments.

Every school child participating will receive a medal.
